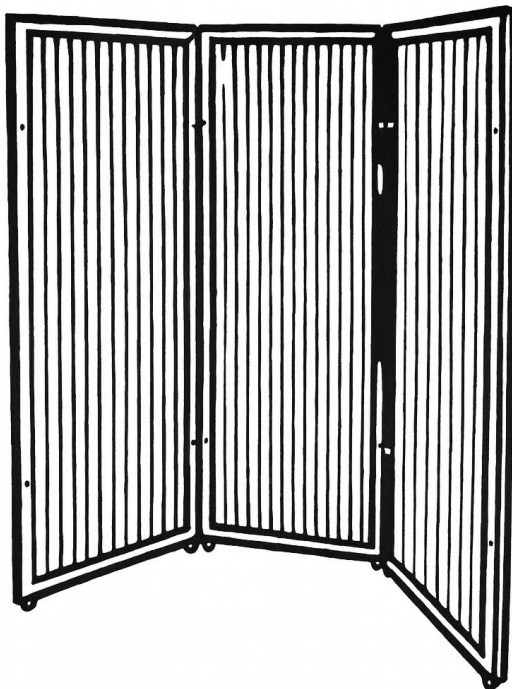

1. General warnings before use!

2. Installation and usage instructions

2.1 Fixing the modules

- Connection via integrated curved profiles
- One unit with junction box (master), the others must be connected in series (slaves)
- Never power the master without connecting the modules
- Ensure that the connectors are correctly aligned
- Ensure that the cable is not connected during assembly

2.2 First use

- Reaches temperature in 5–10 minutes
- Initial odour possible due to running-in (not a fault)

2.3 Regular use

- Front radiation only
- Do not install near sockets
- Ensure that the plug is accessible
- If permanently installed, it must be separated from the mains (category III)

3. Cleaning and maintenance

- Always unplug before cleaning
- Wait for it to cool down (at least 15 minutes)
- Do not spray with water or immerse
- Use dry or slightly damp cloths (no abrasives)
- No maintenance required

Warmset does not supply a thermostat by default.

Upon customer request, the following can be supplied:

- a certified thermostat, or
- a smart plug that complies with current regulations.

It is the responsibility of the installer or end user to ensure that the control system used complies with the following requirements:

- Automatic adjustment of heating based on room temperature
- Energy class at least A
- Recommended advanced features:
 - Time programming
 - Presence detection or open window detection
 - Remote control (e.g. via app or Wi-Fi)

All control devices used must comply with:

- Directive 2014/35/EU (electrical safety)
- Directive 2014/30/EU (electromagnetic compatibility)
